Norman Telfer started attending workshops at Project Ability in 2013 when he was a principal contributor to the social history project Lennox Castle Stories (www. lennoxcastlestories.co.uk). Norman had spent many years in Lennox Castle Hospital and had an almost photographic recall of his time there. Taking part in the project had brought him back into contact with old friends from the "Castle" and after the project was completed Norman continued to attend workshops.
