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Welcome



Planned Replacements

We are already several months into our new planned replacements programme and have some exciting updates for you!

Upcoming Projects

We have several projects that will go on site over the next 2 months:

- Window replacements in Thurso
- New gas heating systems in Milngavie
- New Quantum heating systems in Fort William.

When replacing windows and heating systems we look for the most energy efficient solutions as part of our continued commitment to reducing your fuel bills. You can find out more about this on the <u>Energy Efficiency</u> part of our website.



Fire Detection Upgrades

A large part of our planned replacements programme this year is our upgrades of fire detection systems. By 2019 we plan to have fire detectors in all rooms of your home. Many of our properties already had this and will be unaffected by these works.

In the first year of this project we upgraded the systems in over 100 properties. In the next year we plan to upgrade the remaining 146 properties. We will be in touch before any work at these properties so that you have all the information you need.

Data Protection

You will have read about recent changes to General Data Protection Regulation, commonly referred to as GDPR.

In August, we will be sending a letter to all tenants with a copy of our privacy notice. This will clearly show which information we hold, what we use it for and your rights.
